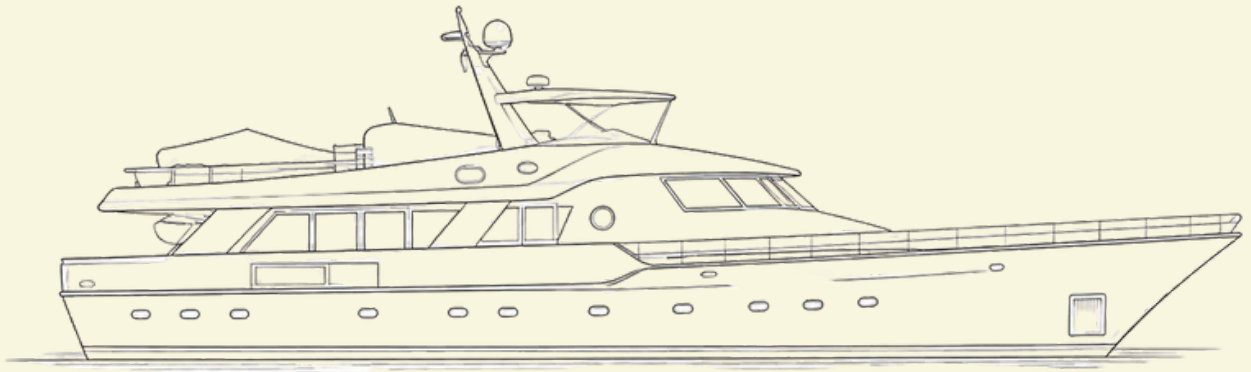
A CLASSIC BENETTI REBORN FOR THE CARIBBEAN

THE STORY



In 1974, in the Benetti yard at Viareggio, DUNE was born into the shipyard's golden era — a true "Gentleman's Yacht," built the way things were built before speed became the point. Steel hull, aluminium superstructure, proportions drawn by hand. She was made to last, and half a century later, she has.

That endurance hasn't come from standing still. DUNE has been refitted three times since — in 2003, 2010 and 2018/19 — each pass sympathetic to her original lines, each one bringing her systems, comfort and finish quietly into the present without erasing the past. What you step aboard today is not a replica. It's the original — fifty years on, still doing exactly what she was built to do.

She has spent most of her life under private ownership, cared for rather than chartered, which is part of why she feels the way she does: unhurried, uncommercial, genuinely lived-in by people who loved her. For the 2026/27 season, for the first time in years, a limited number.

THE CARIBBEAN SEASON

A LIMITED CHARTER PROGRAMME

DUNE's 2026/27 season is deliberately small. Christmas and New Year unfold in St Barths, among the Caribbean's most storied anchorages, before she relocates to Antigua for a considered run of bespoke itineraries through to April. There is no fixed route pressed on every guest — each charter is shaped around the people aboard.



St. Barths

Christmas and New Year, spent in one of the most exclusive corners of the Caribbean. Anchor off Gustavia, step ashore for world-class beach clubs and boutiques, and return each evening to a yacht that feels like your own private address on the water.



Antigua

Sheltered Leeward Island anchorages, secluded coves few charter guests ever see, and the infectious energy of Antigua's celebrated race-week — all within easy reach of DUNE's Caribbean base from January to April.

We cook around the season, prioritising fresh, local produce and the day's catch whenever it's available. A dietary and preference questionnaire is sent ahead of every charter so we can accommodate requirements wherever possible. Please note: given the compact galley, we're unable to guarantee a fully allergen-free environment or rule out cross-contamination entirely.

FOOD & BEVERAGE PROVISIONING

Food and beverage provisioning is paid for by the customer in advance. Provisioning is arranged according to the customer's preferences, requirements, and agreed budget, and includes the purchase and delivery of the planned food, refreshments, and alcoholic beverages for the charter. Any additional provisions requested during the charter, beyond the agreed and pre-paid provisioning, will be charged separately.
